Meteorological Service of Government of Andorra

Background:

- In 1980, The General Council of Andorra signed an agreement with Météo France for the preparation of daily weather forecasting during winter season.
- In 1990, the Service of Industry expanded this agreement to 365 days a year and added a daily snow avalanche risks prediction bulletin during winter season.
- From there, Météo France has provided freely for Government's Meteorological Service a range of products for monitoring and forecasting weather in Andorra:
 - 2 weather forecast bulletins: morning and afternoon.
 - 1 surveillance map offering meteorological alerts in Andorra and neighboring departments.
 - 1 forest fire forecasting map.
 - Maintenance assistance of Government's automatic weather stations.



Meteorological Service of Government of Andorra

Background:

- In 2012, the Ministry of Economy signed the agreement's updates which also included all the tools that were performed in the past by the Meteorological Service of Govern of Andorra.
- Since the signature, the Meteorological Service has been centralizing all the data provided by three weather station networks in Andorra (CENMA, FEDA and the Meteorological Service) for providing continuous and accurate data to Météo France for the treatment and process of specific bulletins to Andorra.

Andorran weather stations currently used by Météo France for performing the meteorological bulletin.

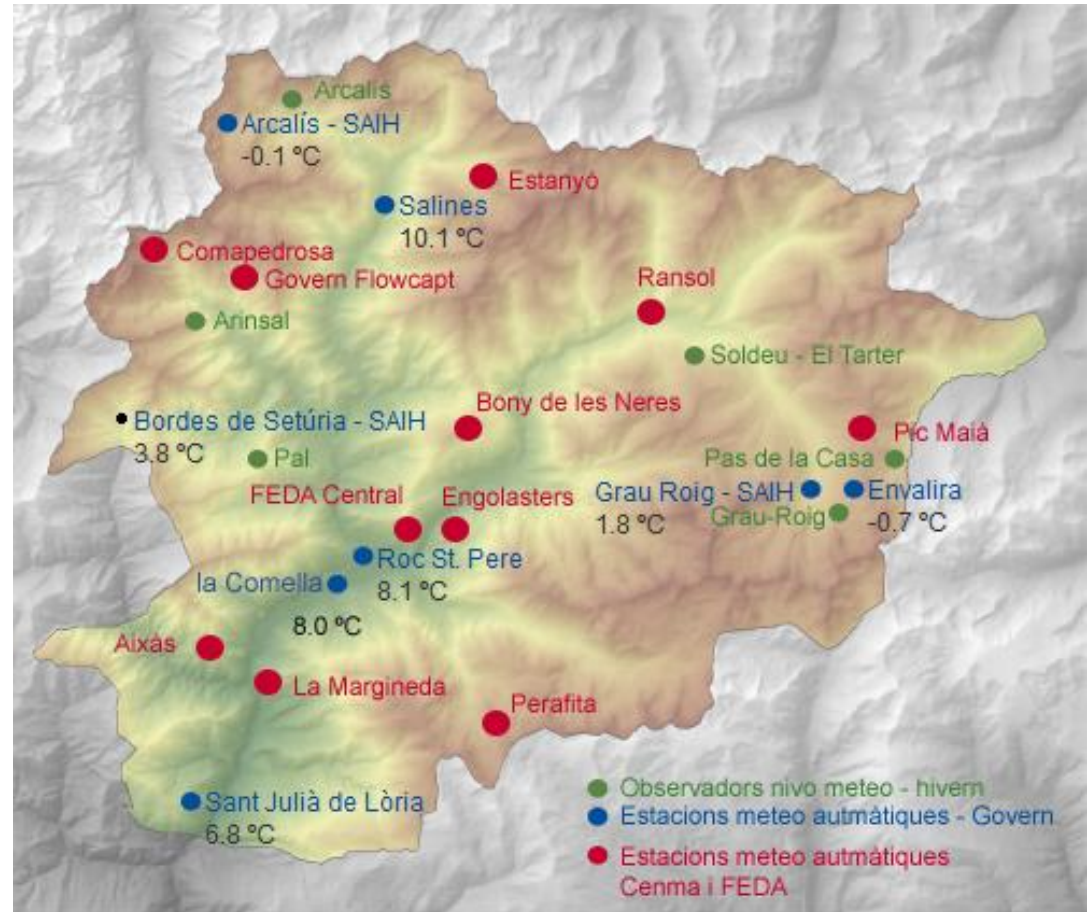




Forward network of automatic weather stations of Government of Andorra, CENMA and FEDA

Two main projects are currently performed :

- The network expansion including Cenma and FEDA's automatic stations (red dots in the figure).
- The implementation of the new server (named Radome) for centralizing the meteorological data and supply it to Météo France via the Internet.

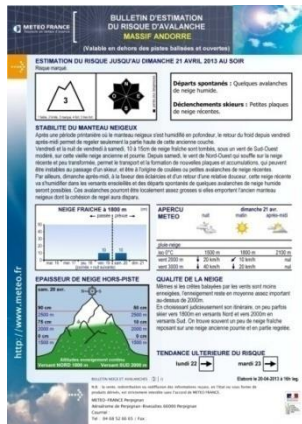

Soyez attentif si vous pratiquez des activités sensibles au risque météorologique ou exposées aux crues; des phénomènes habituels dans la région mais occasionnellement dangereux (ex : mistral/orage d'est, montée des eaux, fortes vagues submergeant le littoral) sont en effet prévus; tenez-vous au courant de l'évolution de la situation.

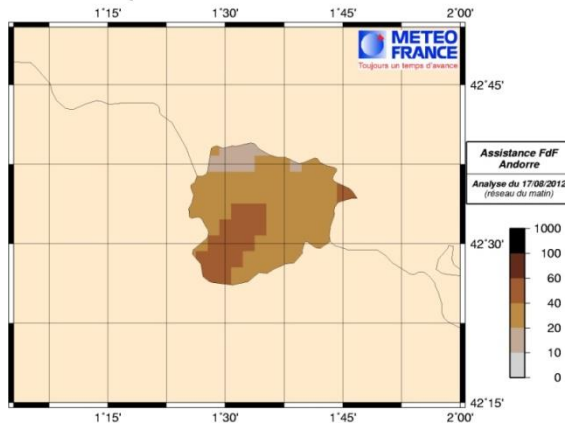
